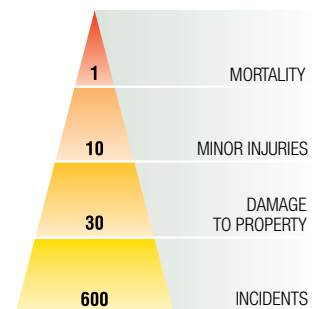
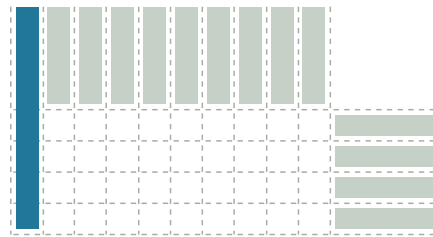


accident and incident investigation
